POLICIES (Amended 2011)

The policies outlined below may be changed by the Executive Board as needed:

Any cancellations or additions of meal reservations for meetings must be telephoned to the chairperson of the telephone committee by: **Monday, 1:00 PM, ONE WEEK PRIOR TO THE MEETING DATE.**

Members who make reservations for themselves or a guest and do not come for lunch are still responsible for these missed lunches. If a member has 2 or more unpaid lunches, she will not be called for upcoming meetings until these meals are paid. She will not be invited to rejoin for the following year until her bill is paid.

If dietary restrictions are an issue, members may bring their lunch but set up will be \$4.00. The Knights of Columbus **DO NOT** provide To Go containers, but members may bring a container from home.

The treasurer will pay for up to five (5) program presenter lunches, from the club treasury.

Split the Pot will be divided. Fifty percent of receipts will go to the Club and the remaining fifty percent will be split among the winning tickets.

When Reeds Spring Schools are closed due to weather, there will be **NO** meeting of Neighbors and Friends.

Dues are \$15.00 per year. Dues may be collected in March, April, and May for the next year to give the Treasurer an operating balance for any expenses necessary until September.
