Dear Members of Neighbors and Friends of Table Rock Lake,

This Month I would like to highlight our **NFTRL PURPOSE**. It is as follows:

"Neighbors and Friends of Table Rock Lake is a non-profit organization whose purpose is to foster friendship among its members and to assist in their introductions into community, social, civic, and educational causes, and to undertake and promote charitable and humanitarian projects within the community."

To date NFTRL has earned and donated to local charities, over ONE HALF MILLION DOLLARS. Money for grants are usually earned by the following fundraisers:

- BUSINESS AND PERSONAL SPONSORSHIPS
- VILLA VISTA CONCERTS
- TWILIGHT, a live and silent auction event (Cancelled 2021)
- CHRISTMAS TOUR OF HOMES, with Galleria, Marketplace and Holiday Café (December 3rd and 4th)
We have 4 properties for the 2021 Home Tour.

In 2020 with the absence of these fundraisers due to Covid, we had to get creative. We held a hugely successful outdoor CRAFT EXTRAVAGANZA in October and increased awareness in PERSONAL SPONSORSHIPS. We still were able to provide Grants for all requests in the amount of \$37,150.

To make any of these events happen, it takes a lot of work. That means a lot of volunteers. We will be asking for **ALL KINDS OF VOLUNTEERS** over the next few months. Please keep in mind our Membership is down so many of us will have to volunteer in more than one area.

This, however, is a terrific opportunity to reconnect with friends you have missed and to meet new friends. Please don't be shy or wait for someone to call you. When we announce a need, please call the numbers we provide and offer any help you can. It will be so appreciated and I promise it will be fulfilling as well.
